The purpose of a Code of Conduct for athletes is to establish consistent expectations for athlete behavior. By signing this Code of Conduct, I agree to the following statements:

- I have read, understand, and will abide by the YMCA of the Chippewa Valley's Competitive Swimming Handbook.
- I will respect and show courtesy to my teammates and coaches at all times.
- I will come to practices and focus on improving my swimming abilities.
- I will demonstrate good sportsmanship at all practices and meets.
- I will set a good example of behavior and work ethic for my younger teammates.
- I will be respectful of my teammates' feelings and personal space.
- I will follow all rules and show respect for all facilities and other property (including locker rooms) used during practices, competitions, and team activities.
- I will refrain from foul language, violence, and behavior deemed dishonest.
- If I disagree with an official's call, I will talk with my coach and not approach the official.
- I will obey all of USA Swimming's rules and Codes of Conduct. (USA swimmers only)
- I will refrain from engaging in or encouraging actions (either in person or via written or electronic communications) that are detrimental to the YMCA of the Chippewa Valley or its members.

I understand that if I violate this Code of Conduct, I will be subject to disciplinary action determined by my coaches and The YMCA of The Chippewa Valley and may be removed from Team.
