AQUATICS COORDINATOR FULL-TIME | CHIPPEWA FALLS YMCA OR EAU CLAIRE YMCA

The YMCA of the Chippewa Valley is looking to hire a full-time Aquatics Coordinator at both the Chippewa Falls and Eau Claire branches!

This position will be responsible for supporting the Aquatics Director and all site aquatic functions. This position will be full time, qualify for full medical benefits, as well as vacation, sick, and holiday pay. This position would also come with a complimentary Household YMCA Membership, as well as discounts on various programs offered by the association. This position does require a once a month weekend rotation, which would affect the hours during the week.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS/DUTIES

1. Maintains constant surveillance of patrons in the facility; acts immediately and appropriately to secure safety of patrons in the event of emergency.
2. Provides emergency care and treatment as required until the arrival of emergency medical services. Follows all Blood borne pathogen procedures when administering any First Aid.
3. Complete all forms and reports according to documentation procedures.
4. Knows and reviews all emergency procedures in accordance with YMCA policies, procedures and completes related reports as required.
5. Knows, understands, and consistently applies safety rules, policies, and guidelines for the pool area.
6. Remains calm and objective when under pressure or when challenged by others.
7. Maintains good communication with the Aquatics Director/Managers and co-workers.
8. Maintains and actively participates in obtaining further job-related certifications and documents completion of certifications with Aquatics Director.
9. Inspect aquatic and safety equipment on a daily basis; ensuring all equipment is in good working condition and notifies Aquatics Director/Managers of any damaged equipment.
10. Advises Aquatics Director/Managers of unsafe and unsanitary conditions.
11. Participate in all in-service trainings and staff meetings as scheduled by Aquatics Director/Managers.
12. Maintain a high level of personal fitness in order to properly perform rescue skills and emergency action plans.
13. Various Administrative duties when required by Aquatics Director (such as scheduling, overseeing program registration, etc)
14. Checking pool chemicals & Sanitizing the pool deck
15. Maintaining the Aquatics flyers on the bulletin boards.
16. All other duties assigned by Aquatics Director

QUALIFICATIONS

- Child abuse prevention training within 30 days of hire date (provided by the Y)
- Ability to maintain certification-level physical and mental readiness
- Physical mobility to properly use aquatic equipment to rescue a 200 lb. person and meet other physical requirements required for job certification.
- Must demonstrate lifeguard skills in accordance with YMCA standards
